General Secretary's report 2025

It is with deep sadness that we share the loss of two of M&DTTA's most cherished members this year — Derek Hodgins and our President, Keith Stacey. Their unwavering dedication and presence were a cornerstone of our community, and their absence leaves a profound void. They will be missed dearly, not only for their contributions but for the warmth and spirit they brought to us all. This year, the M&DTTA has successfully organised five Open events, with the Christmas 10 expected to be the sixth, subject to favourable weather conditions. Sincere appreciation is extended to all organisers and marshals for their dedicated efforts. Alex Royle of Manchester Bicycle Club delivered an outstanding performance by securing championships in the 25, 50, 100, and 12-hour events, as well as winning both the Middle Distance Championship and the Open Best All Rounder competition. Joanna Cebrat of 360cycling was awarded the Ladies Best All Rounder (BAR), while Nicholas Smith of Manchester Bicycle Club achieved the Junior BAR title. Duncan Whalley won the Junior 10 Mile Championship, and Isla Johnson Wells of Buxton CC received the Wagstaff Award for best first-year rider. The Cheshire Points Series again enjoyed strong support this year. Alex Royle claimed the Open series, and Gail Lowe secured the Ladies series. All prize monies have been distributed accordingly. Details regarding next year's counting events are available at www.mdttta.info. The Annual Lunch and Prize Presentation was highly successful, with sixteen trophy winners receiving awards from guest presenter Sally Cunliffe of Velotik Racing Team. Last season's Prize Presentation Lunch will take place on Sunday, 1st February 2026, at Middlewich Masonic Hall. All are welcome to attend this buffet lunch. Tickets, priced at £20, can be obtained from Mavis Ross at mavisinlymm@aol.com or 01925 75 5080. Members interested in contributing further to the M&DTTA are encouraged to consider joining the Committee. The responsibilities are manageable, involving six friendly meetings per year via Zoom and opportunities to marshal any M&D event throughout the season.

RULES OF THE ASSOCIATION

- 1 The title of the Association shall be "MANCHESTER AND DISTRICT TIME TRIALS ASSOCIATION".
- 2 The objects of the Association shall be the co-ordination of the "Amateur Time Trial" activities of the affiliated Clubs and the promotion of such events and competitions as may be decided upon from time to time. Affiliated Clubs shall be confined to those affiliated to the Manchester District of the CTT and adjacent districts. Service members of affiliated Clubs may, if they so wish, ride in the name of their Service Clubs, provided the name of the affiliated Club appears on the Start Sheet.
- 3 The Association shall consist of Clubs affiliated as such.
- 4 Each affiliated Club shall be entitled to be represented at General Meetings by two delegates as set out in rule 9.
- 5 Any delegate unable to attend a General Meeting shall be entitled to appoint a substitute, provided that written notice is given by the delegate to the Secretary

- 6 before the meeting. The Officers of the Association shall be: President; not more than vice-Presidents; Hon. Secretary; Hon. Treasurer; Hon. B.A.R. Secretary; Hon. Time Trials Secretaries.
- 7 The Committee shall consist of the President, Hon. Secretary, Hon. B.A.R. Secretary, Hon. Time Trial Secretaries, Hon. Treasurer and 9 others who shall be delegates to, or Officers of, the Association. Should a member be absent from three consecutive meetings he shall, if the Committee so decide, cease to be a member of the Committee.
- 8 The Officers and Committee shall be elected annually by ballot at the Annual General Meeting.
- 9 Subscriptions to the Association shall be decided at the Annual General Meeting for the following year and shall become due on January 1st. The subscription shall be **£40.00** for each affiliated Club.
- 10 The accounts of the Association shall be presented as at October 31st each year. A Club whose subscription for the previous year has not been paid shall not be entitled to send delegates to any meeting. A Club wishing to resign from the Association shall notify the Hon. Secretary in writing before 31st December of any year or become liable for the following years' subscription. A Club which has not paid the current years' subscription shall not be entitled to take part in combined events.
- 11 All funds belonging to the Association shall be under the control of the Committee and shall be banked in the name of the "MANCHESTER AND DISTRICT TIME TRIALS ASSOCIATION" and shall be withdrawn as requested on any two signatures of the President, Hon. Treasurer and Hon. Secretary.
- 12 One or more auditors, none of whom shall be members of the Committee, shall be elected annually.
- 13 The Hon. Secretary for the time being shall be entitled to take any legal proceedings which may be necessary on behalf of the members of the Association if so directed by a vote of the Committee.
- 14 The Annual General Meeting shall be held before the end of January to receive the Annual Report and Balance Sheet, to elect Officers and Committee who shall act for the coming year and to transact such other business as may be proper :
- a) At least 6 weeks written notice of the Annual General Meetings shall be given and items for inclusion on the agenda must be received by the Secretary at least 4 weeks prior to the date of the meeting.
 - b) Two copies of the agenda papers shall be sent to the Secretary of each affiliated Club and 1 copy to each Officer of the Association at least two weeks prior to the date of the meeting.
 - c) Every Officer and delegate, each of whom, being present at the meeting shall be entitled to one vote.
 - d) The quorum shall be ten.
- 15 An Extraordinary General Meeting shall be convened when a requisition for such a meeting is made in writing to the Hon. Secretary by ten or more delegates and/or Officers, or when circumstances arise or may be set out elsewhere in these rules.
- a) At least two weeks notice of such a meeting shall be given and items for inclusion on the agenda must be received by the Secretary at least ten days before the date of the meeting.
 - b) Two copies of the agenda papers shall be sent to the Secretary of each affiliated Club and one copy to each Officer of the Association at least five days before the date of the meeting.
 - c) Voting and quorum shall be as at the Annual General Meeting.

- 16 The Committee shall meet as often as business shall demand and shall have power to transact all business of the Association, including the power to fill casual vacancies among Officers and Committee. Seven clear days notice of each Committee Meeting, together with a copy of the agenda shall be sent to each member of the Committee. The meetings may perambulate at their own discretion.
- 17 The Association may organise Combined Clubs events on dates and courses as approved by the Committee of the Association. Starting times shall be arranged so that the several events are run as a Combined Time Trial. The Association will undertake to provide the Timekeeper(s) and arrange for the publication of Start and Result Sheets.
- 18 Each Club taking part in a combined Time Trial shall make its own arrangements with regard to handicapping and prizes and shall be required to provide its quota of Marshalls and Checkers.
- 19 a) The Association shall promote annually a B.A.R. Competition over 25, 50, 100 miles and 12 hours to be calculated in a similar fashion to the British B.A.R. Competition and to be confined to member Clubs affiliated to the Association in any event promoted in the area of the Manchester D.C. of the CTT. and appearing in the M&DTTA Handbook, provided that the event is timed by an official CTT Timekeeper with an CTT watch on an CTT course. In cases where there is no qualifying event at a particular distance in the Manchester area, then the Committee will nominate an alternative event.
- b) Promoters of eligible events as defined above shall be requested to send the Hon. B.A.R. Secretary a copy of their result sheet within 28 days of the event.
- c) The last qualifying date for the B.A.R. competition shall be 30th September in each year. Claims with supporting result sheets should be submitted to the Hon. B.A.R. Secretary by the 31st October in that year.
- d) Awards will be made to the fastest three riders and to the first and second teams of 3 riders. Certificates will also be awarded, graded Gold, Silver and Bronze, for riders achieving 22, 21 and 20 m.p.h. Ladies and Tricycles to be 1 m.p.h. less respectively.
- e) The Association shall promote annually a Junior B.A.R. competition over 10 and 25 miles calculated on the basis of the National CTT Junior B.A.R. competition and confined to members of Clubs affiliated to the Association. Rules regarding events, timekeepers, etc. and awards are as in Rules 19 (a), (b) and (c) above.
- f) Claims in respect of the Junior B.A.R. competition should include full supporting result sheets and may be made by the claimant or by some person on his or her behalf and should be submitted to the B.A.R. Secretary by 31st October.
- g) The Association shall promote annually a Ladies BAR competition over 25, 50 and 100 miles calculated on the basis of the National CTT Ladies BAR competition and confined to members of Clubs affiliated to the Association. Rules regarding events, time-keepers etc are as in Rules 19(a), (b) and (c).
- 20 The M&DTTA will promote annually, a middle distance Championship to be run over the M&DTTA Championships at 25, 50 and 100 miles. The winner to be determined by average speed over the three distances. An award will also be made to the fastest Vet on standard m.p.h. and fastest Lady. A team award to three riders from the same Club to be determined in the same way.
- 21 The Rules of the Association shall not be altered or added to except by a vote of not less than two thirds of such Officers and delegates as are present and voting at a General Meeting convened in accordance with the Rules. Full particulars of such alterations and/or additions as shall be proposed shall be set out in the notice convening the meeting.
- 22 In the event of any questions arising as to the correct interpretation of these Rules the decision of the Committee shall be final.

POINTS COMPETITION FOR 2026

Sponsored by "Cyclists for Cyclists"

In 2003 the committee of the M&DTTA passed a resolution enabling the introduction of a new season-long competition based on points secured in a number of selected events, at various distances, to be decided on by the committee. Only events in the M&DTTA handbook will be eligible and the selection of events is based upon offers from affiliated clubs. Any affiliated club can offer their event as a counter as long as it fits in with the general scheme, which this year will have **twenty** events spread throughout the season. The competition does not replace any other, indeed it is hoped that it will encourage entries in the longer distance events. The rules in 2004 were modified with more events to count, and to choose from, and a greater points differential in favour of longer distance events. The twelve hour was also included.

In 2020 the format was changed to two separate competitions, one for open riders and the other for female riders. The points awarded and the prize values will be equal for both competitions.

Rules are now as follows:-

1. The competition will be known as the Cheshire Courses Points Series and comprise of separate series for open and female riders.
2. There will be twenty nominated events in which to gain points.
3. The best **ten** positions per rider will count toward the individual awards.
4. A team shall consist of three riders for the team awards.
5. Cash prizes will be awarded to the three riders with the highest points total and the three teams with the highest points total.
6. All riders of affiliated clubs who finish an event will gain at least five points.
7. Points will be awarded on the following basis:-
Events at 10, 25 & 30 miles - 50 points to the winner down to 6 for 45th place.
Events at 50 miles - 60 points to the winner down to 6 for 55th place.
Events at 100 miles & 12 hours - 70 points to the winner down to 6 for 65th place.
All other finishers - 5 points.

9. Riders do **NOT** need to register to participate.
10. All affiliated clubs to be notified of qualifying events before the start of the season.


